

# KI warns of strike if CDA summary regarding NARC land is not turned down

ISLAMABAD, August 2: The Pakistan Kissan Ittehad warned the government of nation-wide protest strike if it does not turn down the summary moved by the Capital Development Authority (CDA) for converting the agriculture research land of National Agriculture Research Center (NARC) into housing society.

"We will wait until July end, and if the government does not reject the CDA summary, the Pakistan Kissan Ittehad (PKI) will

launch nationwide protest strike and hold demonstrations in front of Prime Minister House and in all the provincial assemblies in the first week of August," President PKI, Khalid Mehmood Khokhar announced during a press conference here.

He said that PKI will protect the interests of agriculture sector for the larger interests of the nation and would come on the streets and roads throughout the country to defend the NARC against land mafia.-PR
