

## Public Auction

Auction of Un-serviceable/Obsolete items will be held on “As is where is” basis at Central Stores, National Agricultural Research Center, Park Road Chak Shahzad, Islamabad dated 24<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup> February 2026 fifteen(15) days after the advertisement of Auction in Newspaper in the presence of the Auction Committee.

The description of items is as follows:-

- Agricultural/Farm Machinery and Equipment (Tractors, Combine Harvesters, Diesel engines, Petrol engines and Pumps, Rotavators, Plows, Seed drills, Threshers, Planters, Lawn mowers Seed Cleaner, Water tanks, etc.).
- Interested people can visit Central Store, NARC and inspect auction-able/obsolete items during office hours (Monday to Friday between 9 AM to 4 PM) by contacting Store Officer, NARC.
- The successful bidder will have to pay the full amount in cash on the spot along with a photocopy of the identity card/CNIC and will have to pay sales tax of 18% on the bid price of each lot and above this, 10% income tax for filers and 20% for non-filers, will be applicable on the price of the lot plus sales tax.
- Successful bidders will have to collect the items/goods from the Central Store, NARC within 5 days during office hours. After stipulated 5 days successful bidder will have to pay a penalty of Rs.5000 per lot per day. After 15 days, the items/goods will be confiscated.
- All bidders are required to bring their original CNIC and proof of being filer.
- All the Excise and Taxation Department matters relating to all tractors and combine harvesters (transfer, registration, token tax and any other dues etc.) will be the responsibility of successful bidder and Pakistan Agricultural Research Council/National Agricultural Research Center will not be responsible for issuing any kind of letter or documents after Auction. All responsibility and payments due in these matters will be the responsibility of the successful bidder.
- Successful bidders will not be allowed to weigh/get the material weighed and throw away the obsolete material in NARC.
- In case of no auction on prescribed days for any reason, the auction will be held within the next one or two working days.
- No one will be allowed to disrupt the order of the office. The committee reserves the right to disqualify any such person from participating in the auction.
- The Chairman Pakistan Agricultural Research Council reserves the right to cancel any or all bids without assigning any reason.
